- **★ June 11, 13, and 14 are ember days. Wednesday and Saturday are days of fast and PARTIAL abstinence. Friday is a day of FULL abstinence.**
- * June 7th is the vigil of Pentecost and a day of fast and PARTIAL abstinence.
- † July 4th falls on a Friday this year. As it is our nation's national holiday, the abstinence is dispensed for the day!
