† We will have a Pot Luck on the last Sunday of every month.

† Monday morning mass at 9 am unless otherwise stated

† December 17, 19, and 20 are Ember Days. Wednesday and Saturday are days of PARTIAL abstinence and fast. Friday is a day of COMPLETE abstinence and fast.

† December 24, Christmas Eve, is a day of COMPLETE abstinence and fast.

† Beginning November 30, the feast of St. Andrew, until December 24th, we recite 15x a day the Christmas Novena for a special intention:

*Hail, and blessed be the hour and the moment
In which the Son of God was born
Of a most pure Virgin Mary
At midnight in Bethlehem in the piercing cold
At that hour vouchsafe, O my God,
To hear my prayers and grant my petitions
Through the merits of Our Saviour Jesus Christ and of His most Blessed Mother, Amen.*

† “Christ is born, glorify Him! Christ from heaven, go out to meet Him! Christ on earth, be exalted! Sing to the Lord all the whole earth; and that I may join both in one word, let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad, for Him who is of heaven and then of earth.
