✠ We will have a Pot Luck on the last Sunday of every month.

✠ **Monday morning mass at 9 am unless otherwise stated**

✠ May 27, 29, and 30 are Ember Days. Wednesday and Saturday are days of PARTIAL abstinence and fast. Friday is a day of COMPLETE abstinence and fast.

✠ April 4, Holy Saturday, is a day of COMPLETE abstinence and fast.

✠ May 23, the Vigil of Pentecost, is a day of PARTIAL abstinence and fast.

✠ **For those wishing to attend full Holy Week services, St. Theresa's in Lebanon will have mass Holy Thursday at 6:00 PM, Good Friday at 3:00 pm, and Easter Vigil at 10:30 pm. Please see Fr. Le or check <https://www.sttheresecmri.org/> for more details.**

✠ **According to church law, all Catholics are required to receive Holy Communion during Easter time (Easter Sunday to Trinity Sunday), as well as to go to confession at least once a year.**

✠ Ascension Thursday is a **holy day of obligation**. Catholics **MUST** come to mass if they have no valid reason not to attend.
